BOSTON HIDDEN GEMS

Day 1

- 11:00 am You've made it to Boston! Stretch your legs on a leisurely walk in Boston Common as you learn of how Boston was first settled through lesser-known stories told by plaques and statues throughout America's oldest park.
- 1:00 pm Head over to Faneuil Hall, stopping by historical sites like the Old South Meeting House, Old State House, and King's Chapel Burying Ground. Free time for lunch, with options including the ever-popular Quincy Market with its 40+ food shoppes, Boston Public Market with its 20+ artisanal shops, and Blackstone Square with America's oldest tavern and oldest restaurant!
- 2:00 pm Walk through Boston's most European neighborhood, the North End (aka Little Italy), where you'll see the Paul Revere House, Old North Church, and more. Immerse yourself in the charming ambiance and explore the narrow streets filled with Italian bakeries, cafes, and shops.
- 4:00 pm Head to your hotel to get checked in and prepared for the evening.
- 6:30 pm Board your harbor cruise, which offers dinner, dancing, drinks, and spectacular views of the city. Enjoy the scenic beauty of Boston's waterfront, witness the city skyline illuminated at night, and catch beautiful photos on this enchanting excursion!

Day 2

- 9:00 am Kick off the day with a view over Boston from the top of the Bunker Hill Monument. Climb the monument's nearly 300 steps and enjoy panoramic views of the city and the surrounding area. Afterward, visit the nearby USS Constitution, the oldest commissioned warship still afloat.
- 11:00 am Drive to Cambridge to explore the campuses and rivalries between Harvard University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). Take a leisurely walk through the campuses, visit iconic landmarks, and soak in the academic atmosphere.
- 12:30 pm Grab lunch at Inman Square, a historic square in Cambridge known for its diverse culinary offerings. Explore the neighborhood and discover delicious food spots that are very popular with the locals but are off the beaten tourist path.
- 2:00 pm Visit the New England Aquarium. Explore the impressive marine exhibits, including the 3-story-tall central tank featuring Myrtle the Turtle. Immerse yourself in the underwater world and learn about marine conservation efforts.
- 4:00 pm Venture to vibrant Back Bay, known for its charming streets lined with Victorian architecture. Enjoy some of Boston's best shopping along Newbury Street, which is home to numerous boutiques, art galleries, and trendy shops. Explore the area and soak in the unique atmosphere!
- 6:00 pm Board your bus to head back home, bringing with you wonderful memories of your Boston adventure. Reflect on the history, culture, and beauty of the city as you depart, and cherish the experiences you had during your visit.
